Multicultural Arts Victoria in partnership with Chapter Kleio No 15 Daughters of Penelope of AHEPA is offering a scholarship for an emerging artist or cultural worker of Greek Heritage to undertake exciting and career-making arts or professional development opportunity.

The Scholarship is open to all artists of Greek heritage from all art forms, including fashion, design, digital media, literature, music, theatre, screen, curatorial and the visual arts.

Scholarship is worth \$2,000

Applications open: Monday 1 May 2017

Applications close: Sunday 30 July 2017

Guidelines

Are you eligible?

To be eligible to apply, you must:

- be aged between 18-30 on 1 May 2017 (this is the eligible start date of the program)
- be a resident of Victoria * (this is defined as being resident for at least 12 months prior to making an application)
- propose an outline of artistic outcome or professional development that would be undertaken (500 words)
- be an Australian citizen or Australian permanent resident of Greek Heritage .

Types of activities funded:

- creation of new work
- exhibition/performance
- periods of research and development
- skills development/ mentorship
- experimentation. (Activities could include a combination of the above)

Selection A committee from the Chapter and MAV will select the recipient based on artistic merit

Outcome The successful candidate/s will be advised of the outcome of their application in writing by 18 August 2017
