



Expression of Interest: Emerge in the North 2018

Multicultural Arts Victoria is currently inviting program submissions for Emerge in the North Festival 2018.

Emerge in the North began with a pilot program in winter 2017 with a free day-long festival at PRACC and a range of smaller local events in the City of Whittlesea. It is a place for artists and communities from Indigenous, refugee and emerging communities to have a voice. In 2018, it will expand to include neighbouring municipalities, and become a series of artist-initiated events in a weeklong festival from June 22-30; with potential for a range of exhibitions, art installations, cooking demonstrations, live music, theatre, storytelling, spoken word, dance and conversations.

Within the festival, MAV can support projects in various ways ranging from links to networks/venues, to publicity/marketing support, to financial support, depending on individual requirements.

In order for the submission to be considered, the project outcome must take place in the northern region of Melbourne (Whittlesea, Darebin, Hume areas) in the week of June 22 to June 30 2018.
